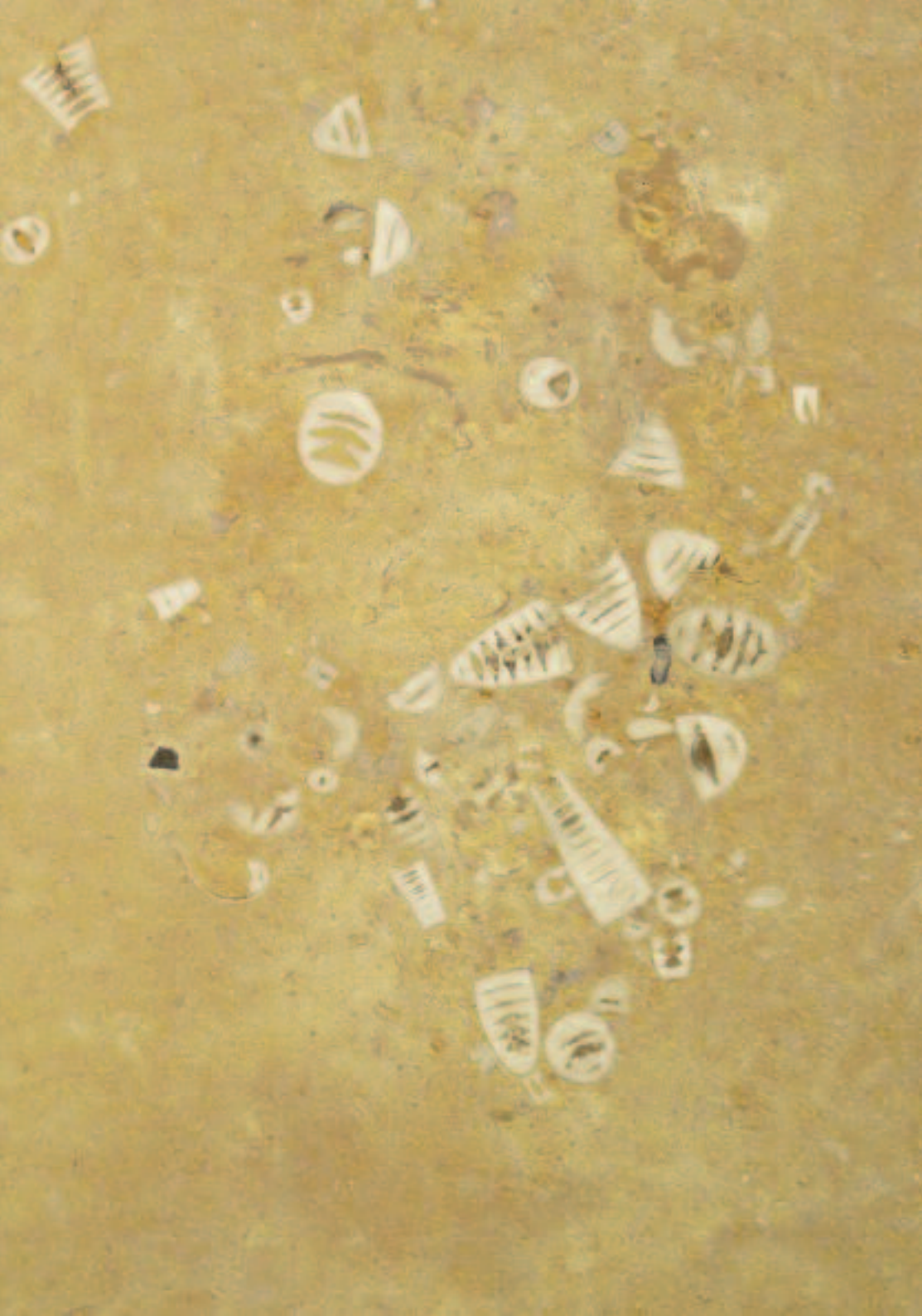

# Stone...

## **Finishes**

Our stones come in a range of finishes – these may be for aesthetic or practical effect. In a bathroom, or swimming pool surround, for example, you may want a finish that is textured for slip resistance. If you are restoring a heritage property, the ageing processes such as antiqued and distressed will help you to match existing materials.

## **How to order**

You will need a specialist fitter to measure and install your stone floor or surface. If you have an existing fitter, then we will simply supply the cut and finished stone that you need, direct to your property, as and when you require, ready for installation. We can also recommend independent stone fitters, if you require, who can help you to assess the appropriate stone and stone-finish for your project.

## **Ageing processes:**

Antiqued *hand-fettered edges and carved undulations*

Distressed *flat surface, rounded edges*

Vintaged *textured, rustic surface*

Tumbled *soft round edges, grained surface*

Weathered *hand fettered edges, open-grain surface*

Riven *naturally split stone*

Worn *hand smoothed edges on a riven stone*

## **Other processes:**

Honed *leaves the surface smooth and flat*

Cushioned *softly rounded edges*

Satino *textured for slip resistance*

# Bibury limestone *distressed*

The character and durability of this pale cream Jurassic stone make it suitable for a variety of domestic uses. It is a close-grained classic English limestone with a broad colour palette from blonde to warmer honey tones, and tracings of scattered fossil and quartz.

## **Specifications**

*Finish* Distressed

*Format* 40cm width x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Bibury limestone *honed*

This is a clean, pale stone in all its forms – but the honed finish, which smooths and refines the surface, enhances this look even further for a classic interior floor.

## **Specifications**

*Finish* Honed

*Format* 40cm width x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Bourne limestone *distressed*

These warm flagstones are full of natural character, enhanced by a hand-worked, distressed finish. Excellent value for money, that is so hard-wearing it has been used successfully in commercial and exterior applications.

## **Specifications**

*Finish* Distressed

*Format* 40, 50 or 60cm widths x random lengths

*Thickness* 1.8cm



# Leonardi limestone *distressed*

A beautiful imported stone with a strong resemblance to Cotwold limestone. The colour is creamy to dark honey with white, fossil markings and a fine grained surface texture.

## **Specifications**

*Finish* Distressed

*Format* 40cm width x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Zuber limestone *honed*

With greyish colouring, fossil markings and charcoal veins this is a very dense, hard-wearing limestone – so the honed finish gives an almost marble-like sheen.

## **Specifications**

*Finish* Honed

*Format* 50cm width x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Zuber limestone *distressed*

This stone has a rich palette of warm, grey tones. The distressed finish is created by hand-fettering and then cushioning (softly rounding) the edges, leaving the surface flat.

*Format* 50cm width x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Java limestone *vintaged*

This is a hard-wearing limestone with ivory to honey colouring, shell-fossil markings and veins. The vintaged finish is created by hand-fettering the edges of the stone and then texturing the surface to give a rustic charm.

## **Specifications**

*Finish* Vintaged

*Format* 50cm width x random lengths

*Thickness* 1.5cm



# Java limestone *tumbled*

You can achieve an instant 'lived-in' look for any room in the house using these limestone flags in a random pattern that is used to form traditional flooring layouts. The tumbled finish rounds the edges and exposes the surface grain.

## **Specifications**

<i>Format</i>	Abbey Pattern (1.5cm thickness); Chapel Pattern (1.2cm thickness)

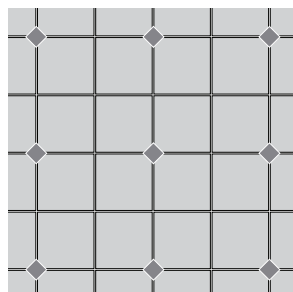


# Fontaine limestone *tumbled*

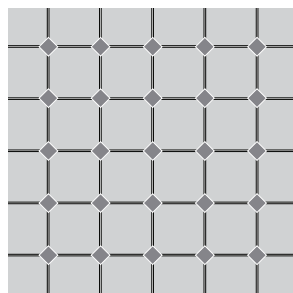
A perfect stone for large, open spaces, Fontaine is dense and clean with subtle variations in tone and occasional fossil markings. A little like marble that has aged and mellowed, this is a sophisticated stone that gets better with time.

## Specifications

<i>Format</i>	40 x 40cm; 40 x 60cm; 40 x 40cm pentagons; 40 x 40cm octagons; cabouchon options

# Beaumont limestone *honed*

The honed finish is created by a high-speed mechanical action that leaves the surface of this fine-grained imported limestone smooth and flat.

## **Specifications**

*Finish* Honed

*Format* 40 x 40cm;

40 x 60cm;

40, 50 or 60cm widths x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Beaumont limestone *distressed*

With a distressed finish that softly rounds the edges of the stone and leaves the surface flat, this imported limestone is versatile and cost-effective, as an alternative to native stones such as Portland which is extensively used in London.

## **Specifications**

<i>Format</i>	40 x 40cm; 40 x 60cm; 40, 50 or 60cm widths x random lengths
<i>Thickness</i>	2cm



# Montagu limestone *distressed*

Requiring very little maintenance, this imported limestone is a versatile choice for both interiors and exteriors, and works equally well in a contemporary setting or a rustic cottage.

## **Specifications**

*Finish* Distressed

*Format* 40cm width x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Neranzo limestone *tumbled*

These flagstones have a rich, warm colour reminiscent of a West Country farmhouse. The fossil and sedimentary markings mean it could easily be mistaken for a native stone – ideal for flooring. It is also very, very hard .

*Finish* Tumbled

*Format* 30, 40 or 50cm widths x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Picazo limestone *honed*

This is a very durable limestone with a clean, open grain. The large format tiles are ideal for large areas of flooring. The tiles are very strong, yet take very little of the room height at just 2cm thickness.

*Finish* Honed

*Format* 60 x 60cm

*Thickness* 2cm



# Dauphin limestone *tumbled*

Limestones of the world come in many hues and textures. This is from North Africa with taupe to grey variations that can work beautifully in chequered patterns with more conventionally pale limestones such as *Fontaine* (see page 22).

*Format* 40 x 40cm

*Thickness* 2cm



# Troove limestone *satino*

Don't let the soft, sandy colour of this imported limestone deceive you. This is a very durable stone that is suitable for both interiors and exteriors. The Satino finish leaves it with a lightly stippled surface.

*Format* 40 x 40cm;  
40 x 60cm

*Thickness* 1.5cm



# St Marc limestone *weathered*

This French limestone has been quarried since the early 19th century. The weathering technique ensures an authentic, rustic look with an open-grain and patination.

*Format* 40cm width x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Hornton limestone *distressed*

This is a simple, clean limestone with very light distressing. The English look and pale brown colouring is a sophisticated alternative to the honey colour of classic English limestone. It makes a perfect, understated backdrop to many interior styles.

*Finish* Distressed

*Format* 30, 40 or 50cm widths x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Ancient Bourgogne *weathered*

An exquisite limestone with abundant character that lends instant heritage to any home. The colouring varies from pale lime through to grey-blue. With a weathered finish it will blend in naturally with old flagstones – an excellent option for both restoration and new-build projects.

## **Specifications**

*Finish* Weathered

*Format* 30, 40 or 50cm widths x random lengths

*Thickness* 2cm



# Treveil slate *riven*

This is a solid, blue-black slate with a riven finish to create the rustic look indoors or out. The stone is hand-split, and comes in a variety of large format flagstones so that it can be laid in a traditional, church formation.

## **Specifications**

*Format* Church Pattern;  
60 x 91cm

*Thickness* 1.5–2cm



# Shepton flagstones *worn*

This is a grey, slate flagstone that is typical of the West Country. The worn process carefully smooths the surface of the riven stone to produce a slightly undulated finish that is normally only found on antique flagstones.

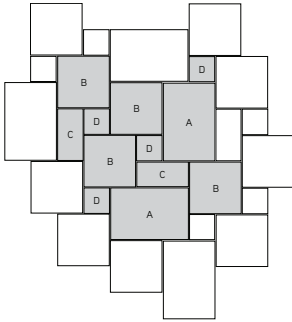

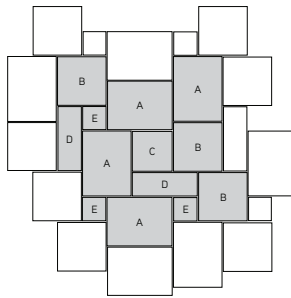

measurements in cm,  
stones in repeat 12.

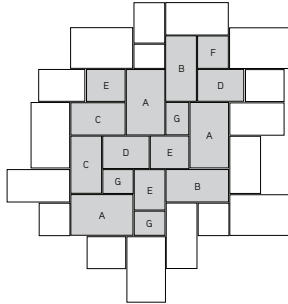


## Church pattern

Each repeat is 2.23m<sup>2</sup>,  
measurements in cm,  
stones in repeat 13.

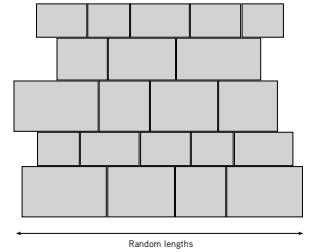
Products that are supplied in 'Patterns' consist of combinations of different size flagstones, which enable you to follow classic patterns such as Church, Abbey or Chapel, as illustrated. This means you can lay your stone floor to these patterns without the waste associated with cutting and fitting uniform flagstones to appropriate sizes. So, for example, one set of 'Church Pattern' consists of 13 stones, and 2.23m<sup>2</sup> in total. The bigger the room, the bigger the pattern you should select, as pattern repeats will be more evident on large, open areas.



### Abbey pattern

Each repeat is 4m<sup>2</sup>,  
measurements in cm,  
stones in repeat 16.
